
PUBLIC NOTICE OF CHANGE OF BOUNDARIES OF COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICTS

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to Chapter 124, Florida Statutes, that on November 16, 2021, the Hernando County Board of County Commissioners, adopted Resolution 2021-197, which resolution changed the boundaries of the County Commissioner districts. Pursuant to the resolution, Hernando County Commission District Boundaries effective November 16, 2021, are as follows:

- A. COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICT 1: Proceeding clockwise, District I shall be that part of Hernando County lying, contained, and situated within the following described area: BEGIN at the intersection of U.S. 19 (Commercial Way) and Northcliffe Boulevard; continue northeast along U.S. 19 Commercial Way to SR 50 (Cortez Boulevard); continue south and southwest along Mariner Boulevard to Elgin Boulevard; continue south and southwest along Mariner Boulevard to Elgin Boulevard; continue south and pto the Linden Drive; continue east and southeast along Linden Drive to Coronado Drive; continue east and southeast along Coronado Drive to Spring Hill Drive; continue west along Spring Hill Drive; continue west along Dunkirk Road to Waterfall Drive; continue southwest along Wu-West; continue north along the Progress Energy ROW-West to Dunkirk Road; continue Boulevard; continue north on Deltona Boulevard to Clipper Court; continue west on Clipper Court to Willow Creek Terrace; continue southwest on Willow Creek Terrace; continue southwest on Willow Creek Terrace to Timber Point Boulevard; continue north on Timber Poi
- B. COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICT 2: Proceeding clockwise, District 2 shall be that part of Hernando County lying, contained, and situated within the following described area: BEGIN at the southwest corner of Hernando County, Florida on the coastline of the Gulf of Mexico; continue north along the coastline to the northern coastal boundary in Section 35, Township 22 South, Range 16 East; continue east along Jenkins Creek to Shoal Line Boulevard; continue northeast along Shoal Line Boulevard to the Weeki Wachee River to U.S. 19 (Commercial Way); continue southwest along U.S. 19 (Commercial Way) to Northcliffe Boulevard; continue southwest and south along Deltona Boulevard to Abeline Road; continue west on Abeline Road to Grand Club Drive; continue southwest along Grand Club Drive to Timber Point Boulevard; continue south lang Timber Point Boulevard; continue south east along Willow Creek Terrace; continue northeast along Willow Creek Terrace; continue northeast along Willow Creek Terrace; continue northeast along Willow Creek Terrace; continue as along Willow Creek Terrace to Clipper Court; continue as along Clipper Court to Deltona Boulevard; continue south along Deltona Boulevard to Spring Hill Drive; continue east along Spring Hill Drive; continue east along Waterfall Drive to Dunkirk Road; continue east along Dunkirk Road to the Progress Energy ROW-West; continue south along the Progress Energy ROW-West to County Line Road; continue West along the Pasco/Hernando County Line to the Gulf of Mexico and the POINT OF BEGINNING.
- COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICT 3: Proceeding clockwise, District 3 shall be that part of Hernando County lying, contained, and situated within the following described area: BEGIN at the northwest corner of Hernando County, Florida on the coastline of the Gulf of Mexico; continue east along the Citrus/ Hernando County Line to U.S. 98 (Ponce de Leon Boulevard); continue southeast and south along U.S. 98 (Ponce de Leon Boulevard) to Yorlz Road; continue west along Yorlz Road; continue west along Cobb Road; continue south along Cobb Road to Wisco Road to West Jefferson Street; continue southwast along Wisco Road; continue south along Suncoast Parkway (SR 589); continue south along Suncoast Parkway to Powell Road; continue west along Powell Road and Elgin Boulevard to Mariner Boulevard; continue South along SR 50 (Cortez Boulevard); continue south along Commercial Way to the Weeki Wachee River; continue west along the Weeki Wachee River; continue south along SR 50 (Cortez Boulevard); continue south along SR 50 (Cortez Boulevard; continue southwest along SR 50 (Cortez Boulevard; continu
- D. COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICT 4: Proceeding clockwise, District 4 shall be that part of Hernando County lying, contained, and situated within the following described area: BEGIN at the intersection of the Duke Energy ROW and Elgin Boulevard; continue east along Elgin Boulevard and Powell Road to Spring Lake Highway; continue south along Spring Lake Highway to the Pasco/Hernando County Line at the southeast corner of Section 33, Township 23 South, Range 20 East; continue west along the Pasco/Hernando County Line to the Progress Energy ROW-West; continue northwest and long the Pasco/Hernando County Line to the Progress Energy ROW-West; continue northwest and west along Coronado Drive to Linden Drive; continue northwest and west along Linden Drive to the Duke Energy ROW; continue north along the Duke Energy ROW to Elgin Boulevard and the POINT OF BEGINNING.
- E. COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICT 5: Proceeding clockwise, District 5 shall be that part of Hernando County lying, contained, and situated within the following described area: BEGIN at the intersection of U.S. 98 (Ponce de Leon Boulevard) and the Citrus/Hernando County Line; continue east, south, and east along the Citrus/Hernando County Line to the Withlacoochee River; continue southeast along the Little Withlacoochee River to CR 471 (Eufaula Road) on the Sumter/Hernando County Line; continue south along CR 471 (Eufaula Road) to the southeast corner of Section 13, Township 23 South, Range 22 East; continue west along the Pasco/Hernando County Line to Spring Lake Highway; continue north along Spring Lake Highway to Powell Road; continue west along Powell Road to the Suncoast Parkway (SR 589); continue north along the Suncoast Parkway (SR 589) to Wiscon Road; continue east along Wiscon Road to Mobley Road; continue north along Cobb Road to Yontz Road; continue east along West Jefferson Street to Cobb Road; continue north along Cobb Road to Yontz Road; continue east along Yontz Road to U.S. 98 (Ponce de Leon Boulevard); continue north and northwest along U.S. 98 (Ponce de Leon Boulevard) to the Citrus/Hernando County Line and the POINT OF BEGINNING.
